



MEET A MEMBER



I grew up in NJ and started riding when I was 8yo. I competed in hunters and equitation, from ponies all the way up through the 3'6" equitation. In my early 20's, I sold my horse and moved on to the next chapter of life; marriage, raising kids, career, etc. I honestly thought that I would never make way back to horses.

About 5 years ago, my friend asked me if I would like to go on a trip with her to celebrate a milestone birthday. We decided on a 100-mile trans Wales riding holiday. I was very excited for this trip, but also terrified because I had not ridden a horse in 23 years. In order to prepare for our trip, I found a barn where I could take some lessons. This led to a year lease on a lovely, dressage horse. I honestly didn't think I had it in me to jump or compete again. At the end of the lease, I found my horse, Star (First Drink). From the first tiny jumps we jumped, to AECs in 2023, Star has been my wonderful eventing partner for the past four years. It turns out that buying Star was just the beginning of the current equestrian adventure. My husband and I moved to our farm, Silver Lining Equestrian, last summer. We now have four of our own horses, and we operate a boarding facility that specializes in young horses and retirees. I am truly grateful that the riding trip with my friend, led to our lives fully immersed in horses and the equestrian community.

Favorite think about FRC: FRC provides a safe, friendly and relaxed atmosphere for schooling, training and learning. The shows are a great place to practice and gain confidence. I definitely feel more prepared for the recognized horse trials after I work through dressage tests and practice show jump rounds at a FRC CT.

FRC Scholarship Application

FRC is proud to be able to award four scholarships annually. In order to qualify for an FRC Scholarship, you must be a current FRC member at the time of your application. Additionally, your request must be for a rare educational opportunity or clinic or a championship competition purpose directly related to your riding discipline. In exchange, scholarship recipients must give back to the club in some tangible way.

Scholarships are for a maximum of \$250; four awarded yearly

- Scholarships for May, June, July events are due April 1st
- Scholarships for August, September, October events are due July 1st
- Scholarships for November, December, January events are due October 1st
- Scholarships for February, March, April events are due January 1st

If there are more than 4 applicants, volunteer service to the club in the current and preceding membership year will be taken into awarding scholarships.

Applicants will be notified of acceptance after review by the FRC Board.
