#### **COGGINS:**

- All horses on grounds must have current negative Coggins.
- Submit this online with your entry.

## SCHOOLING JUMPING ROUNDS on Saturday:

- We will offer schooling rounds at each height.—starting with Grasshopper and going to Modified.
- Rounds are \$5 each and may be paid for when entering the show or the day of the show in the show office.
- All horses doing just schooling rounds must pay stall or grounds fee, non-compete horse fee and the processing fee and present current negative Coggins.
- Schedule for heights will be posted on website by Thursday prior to the show and at the Show Office by 1:00 pm Friday.

## **SCHEDULE:**

- Times will be posted on the website @ www.foothillsridingclub.org by Wednesday prior to the show.
- If the show is running multiple dressage rings it may not be possible to "build rides" i.e., Intro A to Intro B to Intro C to Training 1 etc...
- Limit of 4 classes per rider per day at the show (a Combined Test counts as 2 classes).
- 2 horses per rider limit. 2 classes per horse/ rider combo IF riding more than one horse.
- See 2023 show rules on one horse being used by two riders.

Please DO NOT request a time of day for your test! It is impossible to accommodate these types of requests. Ride times will be between 8 AM and 5 PM. If you can only ride at a certain time (i.e., afternoon) and the class is scheduled for a time other than that then you may have to ride your test HC (not with the class) if the Show Secretary agrees do this. The "note to Secretary" section is to inform the Show Secretary of special requests—such as if you will be using Club Bucks, you want to ride the same test back-to-back, you are a trainer and need to space your rides away from your students or you would like to ride at the beginning or end of the class. We will try to accommodate these types of requests IF WE CAN.

## **SCHOOLING:**

- Schooling will be allowed Friday from 1 PM until dark.
- Lunging permitted in DESIGNATED lunging rings only (not show or schooling rings).

#### **SHOW OFFICE:**

- Show office will be open Friday from 1-6 PM, Saturday at 7 AM, Sunday at 7:30 am
- Please check in at the show office to get your number BEFORE schooling.

# **STABLING:**

- Stabling assignments will be posted on website by the Thursday before the show and posted at the show office Friday by 1 PM.
- Bedding is NOT provided. Bring your own bedding, feed, hay, buckets, etc.
- You DO NOT need to strip stalls. No deposit is required.
- All stalls must have an FRC stall card (cards will be on paid stalls). If you use an empty stall next to you, you WILL be charged!

<u>Stabling Requests</u> – ONE NAME PLEASE (stable next to, Trainer OR Barn OR Rider name) **Type IN THE SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS SECTION**—we do not necessarily know your barn's name or your trainer's name so let us know!

#### **RULES:**

- Review FRC show rules on the website, ESPECIALLY the refund policy. USEF and USEA rules generally apply.
- You may have a reader for a dressage test but NOT an eventing test.
- Any horse on grounds must check in at show office with negative Coggins, pay fees, and get a number (even if just walking on grounds).
- ALL riders must wear protective head gear while mounted with harness fastened.
- Coats/braiding not required.
- Tall boots not required but appropriate footwear with heels is.
- No refunds after closing date unless your slot can be filled. See refund policy on website.
- Dogs must be leashed at all times and NOT be near any in-gate.
- Ribbons for 1st through 6th in all classes. Classes may be combined or split depending on entries.

These shows are meant to be a low key, pleasant showing experience for all horses and riders. We will try to accommodate special tests and special requests when possible.
