

## FRC Cross Country Schooling Day @ FENCE

DATE: September 7th, 2025

**Bring registration form to the tent on the FENCE House side at the beginning of the trail system. Registration from 8:30 AM - 4:00 PM, Course cleared by 5:00 PM**

### Fees:

\*Schooling Fee: \$40 for FRC Members, \$50 for non-members.

\*\*Checks payable to FRC.

### Water Complex Reservation:

Groups or individuals interested in schooling the water complex **must** email Margo Savage at 200redgate@gmail.com and reserve a time in advance. Groups of 2 will be combined, no more than six in one group. Each group will have 20 minutes to school the water complex. Once you have received a time please make sure you are on time and prompt. If you are a "no-show" you will be liable for the fee for your reserved time slot.

### Entries:

All entries, fees, and release forms will be taken upon arrival at the FENCE Trail Tent (on right, just inside the main entrance to FENCE at 3381 Hunting Country Road, across from the show grounds).

### Rules:

1. FRC RELEASE FORM must be signed by rider, or by parent or legal guardian, if rider is a minor, under 18. RELEASE may **not** be sign by trainer or instructor. Those without proper signature will not be allowed to ride.
2. Negative coggins on participating horse (with in one year) is required.
3. Rider must be accompanied by an instructor/coach or person responsible for their safety. Instructor may ride without paying the fee if they do not use the jumps or water complex (their horse is their transportation only).
4. ASTM/SEI approved helmets **MUST** be worn with harness secured when mounted. Safety vest required for all those who are jumping. The wearing of medical arm bands is highly recommended.
5. USEA safety and cruelty rules apply. Violators will be asked to leave the grounds.

### Parking:

Participants can park in the FETA parking field. Overflow parking will be at the showgrounds.

### Water:

Nearest water is at the FENCE Center flagpole or at the Show Barns. Please bring your own equine and people refreshments.





# TEAM TATE ACADEMY SYMPOSIUM

The Team Tate Academy 5 Year Anniversary Symposium (June 27-29) included presentations, interactive lectures, demonstration rides and symposium-style lessons featuring Jillian Kreinbring, Susanne von Dietze-Pollak and JJ Tate.


This event was beyond amazing! It would be impossible to summarize the contents without writing an essay, but below are some notes that spoke to me in my riding journey:

**Jillian Kreinbring's** agenda:

- What is contact...
- Anatomical & Functional Underpinnings of Contact
  - Hindquarters
  - Back
  - Neck & the Cervical Thoracic Junctions
- Contact Faults
  - Compression and Behind the Vertical
- What Are We Really Feeling

Notes:

- As it relates to flexion of the lumbo-sacral joint: upper joints govern the lower joints; if no flexion of the lumbo-sacra joint, you're missing a key ingredient for contact!
- The image below is from Dr. Deb Bennett – as described by Jillian, “the coordination between the longissimus dorsi and the medial gluteal works like a cantilever model. This is especially noticeable during canter departs and collected movements and can be strengthened by working on hills and canter transitions”.



- The Cervical Thoracic Junction (CTJ) – when this is raised, the withers can elevate, the neck can lengthen and the forehead can lighten. This can only happen when the longissimus dorsi are not tense. This visual was discussed at length in comparison to what we all think of as needing to raise the thoracic sling. The thoracic sling acts like a dynamic stabilizer and is not what lifts the front end. That is what the cantilever (image above) does.

**Susanne von Dietz-Pollack** managed to get a flight out of Israel during a really scary time. She gave a really interactive presentation noting that:

- Movement is 3-dimensional → it creates spirals
- Rotation gives a lot of strength → think of twisting a towel
- Suppleness = positive tension
- Legs & hands are the frame-work → the seat is the main-work
- The pelvis is the connection center
- She also gave a phenomenal lesson to a demo rider, where we could see her presentation in practice.

**JJ Tate** did some demo rides on her horses while the other clinicians presented. It really put a solid visual to the concepts we learned about. JJ also gave some lessons, for which Fari and I got to participate on Sunday. I left the weekend with a deeper appreciation for the horses' anatomy and also a feeling of overwhelm of all the things I have yet to learn!



# FRC Scholarship Application

To be eligible, applicants must have logged a minimum of 4.5 hours of volunteer time with FRC. Scholarship recipients are required to "payback" their award in some way, such as by writing an article for the newsletter, speaking at a monthly meeting, etc.

Each member is eligible for **one scholarship per year**.

Applications must be submitted at least **6 weeks before** the proposed event. T

The scholarship award amounts are based on the number of volunteer hours logged with FRC:

- **4.5 hours** = \$250
- **9 hours (full day)** = \$500

A total of **\$2,000** is available each year, with a **\$500 cap** per scholarship recipient.

If there are more than 4 applicants, volunteer service to the club in the current and preceding membership year will be taken into awarding scholarships.

Applicants will be notified of acceptance after review by the FRC Board.




