Intro level will do dressage and ease of handling only; Levels 2-5 will do all three phases - dressage, ease of handling, and speed.

Dressage will be in the outdoor arena. Ease of handling and speed phases will be in the indoor arena.

Ride times and a course map will be made available within the week prior to the show. The show will be conducted and judged in accordance with the rules of USA Working Equitation.

It is the competitor's responsibility to read and understand the rules prior to the competition. The 2026 USAWE rules allow Level 1 riders to receive a 5-point penalty in lieu of disqualification for performance-related infractions. Level 1 and Level 2 riders may have a caller for all trials. Ride times are considered tentative, and it is the rider's responsibility to know the entry order and monitor the progress of the trial. USAWE allows 60 seconds for a rider to appear at the gate after being called. For a complete list of rules, visit www.usawe.org/competitions/rules.

Negative Coggins required.

All riders must wear ASTM-certified helmets whenever mounted.

Intro Level: \$85

Levels 2-5: \$110

Stalls: \$40 (Bedding NOT provided)

RV parking: \$30 per day

Trailer-in Grounds Fee: \$25

Spectator Admission FREE

** FRC Members may pay up to 50% of entry fees with Club Bucks!

Breakfast, lunch, and snacks are available for purchase on the grounds.

All horses, including non-showing, must wear a number when out of their stalls/away from their trailers.

Minors may not handle or ride stallions.

Dogs must be leashed or contained at all times.

Porta Johns located next to the show office.

Competitors MAY NOT take their horses into the covered arena once the obstacle course is set.

Course walk times will be announced when the obstacle map is released.
